Wake Up; Time is Running Out

Chapter 2:

Practical Instructions

As you go through each section in this book, highlight or underline anything the Spirit quickens to you. **Remember to process each truth that is divinely revealed to you in the Spirit, especially if you are convicted.** If you process truth in the Spirit (repent of what is contrary to the truth and embrace the truth by faith), peace and revelation will flow. You should hear directions about what to do, what not to do, and any hindrances that are in your way. Remember to keep it simple!

One important thing to remember is to guard against ways that seem right. The devil will try to distract you with "good ideas" to fix your problems, but he can only do this if you are lord. Stay in the Spirit and let your Teacher do the work! **As soon as you try to fix your spiritual problems by yourself, you have become lord.** When you are lord, you are unable to hear the Spirit's instructions because you are in the flesh, where satan always has access. **Do not try to help God do His work in you.** Keep your heart and thoughts focused on Him, and He will add all that is needed.

It is important to slow down as you go back to deal with your foundation. I cannot stress how important this is! Be sure the Spirit is directing each step. When you know the Spirit has started working on a particular area, it is crucial to stay focused on Him to complete the work. Be sure the Spirit, not you, is initiating any change of direction.

Once again, do not complicate things! Ask the Spirit to show you how to repent of each hindrance. **The Holy Spirit is your Teacher, and He wants you to enjoy fellowship with the Father and Jesus more than you do.** He has the answers!

The Holy Spirit desires that you enjoy fellowship with the Father and Jesus more than you do.

I am going to say this again because it is absolutely crucial for this process to work properly: **Do not try to do this work in your spiritualized flesh.** Do not decide what you need to fix! Instead, ask the Lord what you need to do. It is a work of the Spirit and He knows why your foundation has not been laid properly. Trust God to do this work!

No Excuses!

If your relationship with God is not working, either God is the problem or you are the problem. **God is not the problem, so that only leaves you.** The problem I had in the early days of walking with the Lord was that I did not know why I was the problem, but I came to the conclusion that if the relationship was not working, there was no excuse for it.

If God has authorized you to obey a command or receive a provision from Him, then He has also authorized everything needed to get it done. It is your responsibility to receive what He has authorized and to use it in a lawful way. Then you can do what He said to do or receive what He said to receive.

If your relationship with God is not what it should be, there are no excuses, only reasons why it is not working. Reasons can be identified and removed until there are no more reasons. Many of you get stuck at this point. You come before the Lord and ask Him to show you the reasons why your relationship with Him is not working. Many of you have told me you do not get an answer so you give up.

In this series we are looking at the overall goal of pressing toward spiritual maturity. We will deal with many reasons why you are not where you should be spiritually. Instead of trying to hear detailed dialogue about all of the reasons (which you may be unable to hear), this book will give you a wide range of reasons why you are not

mature. Every time the Spirit convicts you while reading this book, you have found another reason why you are not spiritually mature and why your relationship with God is inconsistent.

Instructions

As soon as the Spirit identifies an area you need to repent of, stop right then and ask the Lord to forgive you. **Confession of your sin is essential in order to stay in God's presence, but repentance to the root level is a much deeper work.** My advice is to get a notebook and a pen. Write down what the Spirit convicts you about. Give each conviction or revelation an entire page and note the date the Spirit shows you an area that needs work.

Remember: God authorizes you to be free from everything the Spirit convicts you about. In other words, you are anointed to deal with each issue He reveals. The Spirit will move on you and instruct you about how to process each conviction until it is no longer a problem for you.

As you go through the book and make a note for each thing you are convicted about, do not get discouraged. Be encouraged! Every one of those reasons you remove through repentance will bring you closer to the goal God has set for you. **God already knows every detail about what He is exposing before you ever recognize it, and He still loves you!** He also knows about every sin He has not yet revealed, and none of those sins cause His love for you to waver.

Do not try to fix what your Teacher shows you in spiritualized flesh, and do not open the door to condemnation by feeling sorry for yourself. In the beginning, you are simply repenting of each conviction in general and making a note of what you need to process spiritually. Then in your quiet times, be sure you are in the Spirit and bring your notes before the Lord. Go through each page, asking the Spirit if there is revelation on any topic He wants to show you. As you feel a flow of peace, go page by page and listen to the Spirit as your Teacher. **You only have to work on the area the Holy Spirit chooses.** All other areas are covered by grace until it is time to deal with them.

There will always be something in your notebook He wants to reveal to you. If He shows you something on a topic, write it on a page with the date He shows it to you. Whether it requires you to stop doing something or begin doing something, start practicing what your Teacher says. Once again, remember to keep it simple! As long as you present yourself to the Teacher with an open heart that embraces all of God's standards, your Teacher will only require you to do whatever He specifies.

All of the items on the other pages in your notebook are covered by grace and do not separate you from fellowship with the Lord. When grace covers an issue, it is not counted against you at the present time, but it is still important. If you are faithful and do not procrastinate, God will deal with each sin in His timing. You can always trust Him to be faithful in the work He does in you.

This does not make sense to the natural mind, but it is the truth. It is truth because God sees the fullness of your decision to repent and your faithfulness to do whatever He shows you. (Chapter 11 gives details about God seeing in fullness.)

Additional conviction and learning how to walk out the fruits of your repentance will be listed on the pages as God gives deeper revelation about each particular sin. This will cause you to break the habit and go to the root problem which is always taking over lordship. It is important to spend time seeking the Lord about how and why you take over lordship in each area.

For example, suppose you have a habit of getting angry. Ask the Lord to show you all of the situations that cause you to get angry. Ask Him if there is a common reason for your anger. Perhaps you only get angry at family members or in certain pressure situations. Then ask the Lord to show you why you get angry in those instances. Study the Word to see what God says about anger and what you should do instead of getting angry. You



Testimony After SOLM Conference: *Wake Up!*

I was surprised to find that the few weeks after the conference in Nottingham were somewhat of a struggle spiritually. I felt quite oppressed at times and also very distracted. When I asked the Lord what was happening, He said, "satan does not want you to have victory and you are under a spiritual attack." He reminded me of the scripture that says, "Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. RESIST THE DEVIL and he will flee from you." After that word, I became very aggressive about rebuking satan and his tricks and focusing only on staying in the Spirit as consistently as I could. This produced a major change for me.

As I began to study *Wake Up!* and prepare my notebook, I read through the entire book several times before writing down the revelations the Lord gave me. (This is what He told me to do.) Then I asked Him where to begin studying and seeking for detailed revelation. The first area He focused on was the 'ways that seem right'. He showed me how satan used these ways to keep me from enjoying consistent fellowship with God. I spoke to Joseph and he said I needed to stay angry at the devil for stealing from me for so many years. What a change that brought! Every day I spent time with the Lord, repenting of everything He showed me and rebuking the devil.

I began to see changes immediately. I felt the presence of the Holy Spirit more consistently and when I edged toward ways that seem right, the Spirit immediately convicted me and showed me what Jesus wanted me to do. **Instead of condemnation, I felt excited that I was being chastened in areas that had trapped me for years. Praise the Lord for these revelations!**

may find that your anger is a fruit of making judgments, which you are commanded not to do in Matthew 7:1. "Judge not, that you be not judged."

The more you explore an area, the more the Lord can show you how to shut every door to the sin and go down to the root reasons why it is a habitual sin for you. The taproot is always taking over lordship, but sometimes it takes time to work your way down the path from the fruit to the root. (The picture of the trees in *My Sheep Hear My Voice* illustrates the path from fruit to root level. It is important to note that the "trunk" of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, that is, your lordship, is always selfishness.) **The Lord has all of the answers you need as He exposes your sin, and He will set you free as you confess and repent.** Let Him do the work to change your heart!

As you read the Bible, hear a sermon or receive direct revelation, add a new page to your notebook every time you are convicted. **Then work through each area as the Lord directs.** Some will be faster and easier than others.

When a problem area has been completely repented of and the Lord says it is no longer a problem, I suggest you move the page to the back of your notebook in a separate section so you can check it from time to time. It is always a good idea to recheck areas where you have gained victory to be sure you are maintaining your repentance. In other words, you continue to practice what God has shown you and you no longer have the habit of the sin. Having this section will encourage you as you see progress being made.

If Satan has had access to an area for years, he will try to re-establish it. You must be vigilant. It helps to have dates on everything God shows you so you can look back and see if you are procrastinating. If you are, repent and bring the problem to the Teacher. If you find you are behind in multiple areas and realize you have put them off for a long time, you may need a page entitled "Procrastination." Procrastination will greatly hinder your spiritual walk.

The more you expand your notebook and the more quality time you spend with the Spirit teaching and correcting you, the faster you will grow. When you embrace His work in you, you will not waste time doing things that seem right but do not produce any fruit.

Conviction is a blessing and you need to see it that way. Without it, you are not considered to be a son or daughter. Hebrews 12:6-8 says, "For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives." **If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?** But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons."

If there is an area that has been a problem for a long time, you can date the issue "a long time ago" and start where you are. **It is crucial to admit where you are, even if you are much farther behind than where you thought you were.** There is great freedom in accepting that you are levels behind where you believed yourself to be because God judges your faithfulness based on where you truly are. If you have struggled a lot, it is very likely you are trying to walk in a level beyond where you actually are.

Make No Assumptions

You may be functioning in ministry and be considered faithful by those around you, but how does God see you in terms of your personal spiritual maturity? He knows every detail about your spiritual growth and your level of development. **It is important that you do not make any assumptions at this point.**

Simply ask the Lord where you are spiritually. He may say you are a toddler or preschooler in certain areas but a fairly functional, mature child in another area. He may say you are in early levels of school when you think you are in more advanced training. He may say you function well as a soldier in some areas but are still in early levels of training in others.

It is important to abstain from comparing yourself to other believers around you. God's standard is for you to reach toward the mark of the high calling He has set for you personally. Philippians 3:14 says, "I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." It does not matter what someone else's level is. **You will give an account for yourself alone.**

Ask the Lord if He considers you to be faithful and at what level. There is great freedom in knowing where you are! If you are behind, God's mercy will cleanse you as you repent, and His grace will take you where you need to go.

How to Use Your Notebook

As you process the instructions in this book, it is important to keep a record of what the Holy Spirit shows you. This helps you identify what you need to repent of and work on, as well as keeps you focused on what the Lord is doing in your life. **Remember that it is important to pray a spiritual covering over your time before the Lord.** The devil does not want you to have victory over him, and he will try to interfere with this process in any way he can.

Greetings Dr Keith

Hope you get back home safe and your trip was nice.

Thank you for challenging me to live for a higher standard in Christian life.

We have been discussing with fellow friends here at the office on the topics you shared with us though there are questions people raise for clarity.

I found your presentation and the discussion we had in groups and even individually with you to be so relevant and very practical. Thank you so much.

I would love you to be my mentor.

When the Holy Spirit reveals an issue He wants to address (sin, lies you believe, new revelation, and so on), the first thing you need to do is make a note of what He says and the date He says it. Then ask the Spirit to show you any revelation you need in that particular area. Go through this process slowly! One revelation may have multiple subcategories that do not need their own page. You may find many revelations about one particular subject.

If you are unable to get additional revelation, ask the Holy Spirit to show you why you cannot hear any details. It may be that it is not the correct time to work on that area, but it may also be because satan is trying to distract you with confusion, misdirection and ways that seem right.

If the Lord is saying to work on the area and you are not hearing instructions, identify your thoughts at that moment. Are you still enjoying the peace of God or do you feel frustrated and upset? What are you thinking and feeling?

If the peace of God remains, simply wait for the Spirit to speak to you and write down what He says. If you are struggling in any way, write down your thoughts. These negative thoughts indicate that satan is speaking to you. Do not get discouraged at this point! Simply move back into the Spirit through repentance and make sure the peace is flowing. Write down all of the thoughts and negative feelings you had. Each one is another hindrance that needs to be dealt with through repentance.

The devil does not want you to know the truth and he will distract you with negative thoughts. You must identify his words and rebuke them. Even if satan is bringing confusion and doubt, you are learning how to identify his voice, which is a great blessing. This is another opportunity to destroy his work in your life.

If the Holy Spirit has identified an area that needs work, simply ask a “yes” or “no” question. Ask if He wants to show you something at that moment. If you do not hear a “yes,” ask Him if you should move to another area; and if so, which area it is. Do not try to force the issue because this opens the door for satan to minister ways that seem right to you.

If the Spirit does flow, once again, identify your thoughts and feelings and write them down. Ask Him to show you excuses you have used or lies you have believed about the topic. Monitor the peace of God in your heart. When the Spirit teaches, the peace of God will flow freely. If it does not flow, something is wrong and satan has some kind of access. Again, examine each thought and feeling. **Be sure you remain in the Spirit the entire time you are working on items in your notebook.**

I always think of satan as God’s sheepdog. When he bites at you with lies, condemnation, ways that seem right and negative thoughts and emotions, run back to your Shepherd! What satan intends for evil, God will use for your good. When the devil’s lies and deceptions are exposed, and you move down the path from the fruit of your sin to the root, his works in your life will be destroyed.

The fruit of all sin comes from the root of taking over lordship from Jesus Christ. Satan has a myriad of ways to deceive you in this area. Every time another sin or lie is exposed, you become more free. **There are other roots attached to the taproot, but the entire root system will be destroyed when you fully submit to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.** Creating and going through your notebook in the Spirit will do this work.

Be encouraged! See conviction as the blessing it is. Letting the Spirit examine every area of your life will set you free. You will begin to enjoy a relationship with God you have never had before. Think of this as the Spirit of God breaking every chain that holds you captive to your flesh and the devil. What an exciting concept!

Remember: Even though this may sound overwhelming, you only have to deal with what the Holy Spirit identifies. Everything else is covered by grace. Do not get overloaded with all of the information you receive. It is a great benefit to you to know every detail of how you have been wrong so you can repent and be set free. Every revelation is a blessing! Every session you have with the Holy Spirit will give you the opportunity to correct an area and become more like Christ. **This is the most effective use of your time as you seek to know the Lord better.**

Maintaining Your Notebook

When you overcome in an area and God says you are faithful, you can move the page to the back of your notebook. This does not mean He will not work on the subject again at a deeper level. Think of the difference between mathematics in first grade versus calculus in college. It is the same topic but much harder material.

Do not get under condemnation and assume you are doing something wrong if you go back to a topic you have not dealt with for a while. **You may be in a higher grade in some areas, but lower in others.** If God deals with an issue again, it does not mean you are failing. **Always ask your Teacher how you are doing instead of judging yourself.**

Maintaining this notebook will change your life dramatically. Commit yourself to learning by the Holy Spirit alone. One wonderful thing about the Spirit is that He can work on an area for a while, and then have recess. He is the Teacher. If He is not teaching or correcting at the moment, relax and rest in His presence. He covers what He is not dealing with. You are in His school.

It is imperative that you stay in the Spirit and remain in God’s school rather than struggle in spiritualized flesh. As I said before, when the Lord confirms you have successfully dealt with an issue, move the page to the back of your notebook. This will be your “maintenance file” and it will include areas where you have attained victory but still need to monitor. Items in

this part of your notebook may be worked on by the Lord again when He wants to deepen and expand the topics so you can grow more.

Remember: If your Teacher addresses an issue again, this does not necessarily mean you have failed. It may mean it is time for advancement! Be sure you ask the Spirit why an issue is being addressed again and do not open the door for satan to lie to you about failing.

One final word before we move on: I encourage you to use a pen and paper to create your notebook instead of a computer. This is what I did over forty years ago and I have never wavered in my commitment to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

The Lord told me that technology can lead to distractions. Trust me on this! I know the way I did it works because of the fruit that is evident in my life. It is too easy to let your mind get distracted when you use a computer and subconsciously you may hold on to control. **It is time to let go of the control once and for all!**

Note: Using technology to look up scriptures and Strong's definitions may help you with your research. However, be sure to ask the Lord about this. He may require you to use reference books because this is necessary to help you slow down and hear His voice more clearly. The key is to take your time and not rush the process.

Assignment

Ask the Lord to show you the reasons why your spiritual life is not as it should be. Write in your notebook any excuses you have made for why you are behind spiritually. Write down any revelation He shows you. As He exposes areas of sin, be quick to confess and repent. As you process what He shows you, be careful not to move into the flesh and condemnation. All repentance should take place in the presence of your Father!

Report on Keith Jenkins' Ministry Trip to Southern Africa

September 2014

This trip included two countries in Europe and five in South Africa and Ethiopia. The trip started in Denmark where I spoke at a church working on applying, in their lives, the teaching in the book, "My Sheep Hear My Voice". I had previously been there for a day seminar and this was a return visit about five months later. The message was well received and there was time for questions and answers at the end. I was also able to share the message of the Ministry regarding 'Hindrances to Faith'. After the last session I flew back to London and then on to Geneva for the Sunday morning programme. Books were waiting for me in London and so, in-between flights, I spent time re-packing for the next part of the trip. In Geneva I was to speak at an international church so they needed a lot of English copies of the blue book.

I had just enough time between meetings but I did end up misplacing some medicines that I needed on the trip. However, the Lord provided replacements later in Botswana. My next meeting after Geneva was after nearly 20 hours of flying, including an overnight journey on an aeroplane. When I arrived I had about 30 minutes to get ready and get to the meeting. It was mid-week so the numbers were between 30 and 50 but the people came ready with pen and paper. The heart attitude and desire to learn was great. Afterwards many purchased the books they needed and the church also bought extra copies for those not able to attend. The next morning, during working hours, some came again as they were hungry to hear more. Immediately afterwards I left directly for the airport!

I had contacted several churches in Harare, about my visit, but none that responded had a service on a Tuesday evening. My flight was early which would have been ideal if they had. (One pastor did get the message very late and could have arranged a meeting.) On that evening my host picked me up in the car. He was an elder in one church and they had a leaders' meeting. Afterwards they invited me to speak there and many of them even prophesied as in Matthew 7:22-23. However, they did not seem to be aware of the serious message I was bringing. They only gave me 10 minutes to share a short testimony while they took 30 minutes prophesying. It turned out that the elder who was hosting me also knew the venue for the meeting in the morning. He was able to take me because he was working with the same ministry. The place I was visiting the next day could not find a place for me to stay as well and yet he had not responded. They had quoted prices for some accommodation and yet my host was part of the same ministry and had already offered his home for me to stay the night but was unaware that I had a need for accommodation. Just a mis-communication but it was a blessing. The location of the meeting was about 10 Km outside the city and all of this was covered I did not have to try and find transport either as my host had a car and the person for the next meeting also collected me from the same place. Otherwise it could have been a serious logistical problem and a lot of money in taxi fares.

The group on Friday morning was not even a church and they had asked me to come and speak at a time which was convenient to me! I only had 8-9am They bought \$100 worth of books and were delighted to hear the teaching. They recognised that what they heard was the truth. Before reaching the airport I was scheduled to meet and speak to some leaders of a black Zimbabwean church. I made it to the airport on time but was the last board the plane!

I arrived in Gaborone in Botswana on time. I spoke at three meetings, all in the centre of the city, organised by people really trying to walk in the message of 'Hearing and Obeying God'. The number of people coming had increased since it started with a just one lady. There was also a men's group developing. The first night I spoke at the Independent Assemblies of God Church in Gaborone on 'Being a Good Soldier' and this seemed to wake up some of the people to see what was going on in the spiritual realm. The following morning I spoke with some local pastors and several churches were invited. At the third meeting, the message was on 'Hindrances to Faith'. The message of simply trusting God was clear and I also shared the same message in my next meeting in Durban, Southern Africa. At the first meeting in Cape Town I shared in detail about 'Sowing and Reaping Love' and in Johannesburg about the greatest commandment, 'To Love God'. Throughout the trip I shared some testimony as some people were struggling and needed this as they had faced some disappointments and were not regularly attending any church.

I face many challenges when I travel. The people I stayed with in Middleburg had given me some cooked sausages and bread. This was my last meeting in the Republic South Africa before the journey to Swaziland. This was all I had to eat when I arrived in Swaziland! The church I visited in Manzini did not do anything to host me properly or feed me. The pastor even asked me to give a donation in the service! I was happy to share the message God had given me and then travelled, by road, the next day to Mozambique. At the border they nearly refused to give me the visa! Normally, visas are issued at borders in South Africa but this practice is now no longer normal. I had planned to travel to the airport and then to Tete in Mozambique. One pastor helped me when I arrived in Maputo and he said there was a bus to the airport but after some enquiries it was not possible and I had to take a three-wheeler taxi instead. I just had enough money for this. When I arrived in the Tete, at around 9pm, I was met by a road engineer at the airport who had heard me before in a meeting. He was very happy to have me stay that night in his home but I knew that, if I stayed the night, in the morning it would be hard to find a public vehicle leaving so early from Tete to the border. Instead, we spent the few hours looking for a bus leaving for the Malawi Border immediately. The engineer was doubtful but took me to a parking area for lorries. In this park there was a lot of activity including some disco entertainment, in English, for the many lorry drivers from Malawi. In amongst all these lorries I was directed to one bus and found a driver who was willing to take me at 4am! There were some opportunists (thieves) and one did get my bag, briefly, but the people with me saw where he went and nothing was lost. The bus was going to Lilongwe but had left late from Johannesburg and therefore had to make an unplanned stop in Tete. This was possibly just for my sake! Praise the Lord.

I had to find somewhere local to sleep a for a few hours because this was far from the centre of Tete and

Copy of an email conversation concerning Keith Jenkins' visit to South Africa

Subject: RE: Obtaining a Mozambique visa

To Andrew. "Can you find out from the internet if there have been any changes to obtaining a visa for British passport holders. I will be trying to obtain a visa at the border between Swaziland and Mozambique. This may not be allowed anymore. Dave mentioned that his daughter was trying to go there and something had changed. Maybe you can also check with him."

Reply to Keith. "There doesn't seem to be any negative press about obtaining Mozambique visas, so it looks OK - just subject to the usual problems of Africa! The Foreign & Commonwealth Office website says: "Tourists may be able to get a single-entry visa valid for 30 days on arrival. However, there have been reports of visitors being refused this service and being turned back from border posts and airports. It is therefore much safer to get a visa before you leave the UK. You must present on entry a return air ticket (for air travellers) and either an invitation from family / friends or a confirmed hotel reservation." The situation seems to be pretty normal, as far as I can see.

To Andrew. "Thanks for your help on the visa. However, there may be another issue. It seems that the spread of the Ebola virus in West Africa has affected travel. One pastor from Nigeria could not return to SA because the Ebola Virus. Can you check and see if there are any restrictions on people moving from Lusaka, Harare, Gaborone on the route I am taking because of the virus.

Reply to Keith. "The LA Times (USA) reported that "South Africa announced on Thursday that all noncitizens travelling there from three of the virus-stricken countries will be turned away, and that South African citizens arriving from the "high-risk" countries of Guinea, Liberia and Sierra Leone will be subject to strict screening, including temperature checks. A fourth nation affected, Nigeria, was listed by South Africa as a "medium-risk" country, along with Kenya and Ethiopia, which have had no reported cases of Ebola, but which South African officials said were major hubs of travel to the area." This should not affect your trip in September, as you are going from Zambia to Zimbabwe to Botswana and then South Africa, so technically you should not fall into their risk category. **However, if they see any recent Sierra Leone, Guinea, Liberia or Nigerian stamps in your passport, they may ask awkward questions.**

To Andrew. "Fortunately I am going with a brand new passport with 48 blank pages. **God told me to do this while I was in Belfast before all this happened.** I just obeyed because I had one or two blank pages in the old one! I was going to visit Kenya but the Lord warned me not to go. Please keep on an eye on this issue. What are the high-risk countries at the moment as I may be going to some of these in November 2014."

Reply to Keith. "That's a pretty cool testimony! The high risk countries are: Sierra Leone, Guinea and Liberia. You will be facing some serious difficulties if you try to travel through them and on to anywhere else in Africa. South Africa has also identified three medium risk countries, where there have been no cases of Ebola yet, but they are major travel hubs. These countries are: Nigeria, Kenya and Ethiopia. Travellers coming from these to South Africa will face some enhanced scrutiny. This is a situation to watch as it unfolds.

Keith to Dave. **"I did not know the Ebola outbreak was going to happen and was unaffected by it. I did have many visas from West Africa but these were in my old passport which would have created a lot of suspicion and delay!!!!"**

one lorry driver offered his cab for this short time before the bus departed. The bus did not go directly to Blantyre but dropped me in a village where I could get a local bus to the border for Blantyre. I was the first to cross the Zobue border and thereby reached my lunch time appointment in the centre of the city.

The meeting was not well attended but one man had really wanted a copy of the blue book since my visit last year. He recognised me in the street on the way to the meeting. He also helped me carry my bags shortly after I got off the bus. I had not arranged this. This was a great help as, otherwise, I would have had to climb some steep hills and get up some steps on my own. The Pastor of the church was interested in the message and I stayed in his home. Other meetings in Malawi were cancelled and I only found this out when I arrived! This does happen in Africa. However, I was able to meet some pastors and then travel to Lilongwe and on to Ethiopia.

In Addis Ababa I had two morning sessions with the workers in the Christian ministry called Compassion. They were all very open to the message. They had a real wake up experience from the teaching last time and wanted me to speak on 'Renewing the Mind'. Many purchased books again. I had two sessions and then another with leaders, staff and students at the largest Pentecostal Seminary set up by the Assemblies of God. I was blessed to speak for nearly 45 minutes. They also got a wake up experience! The leader was very thankful and was very open for me to come back. This was a great and very effective trip, in spite of some disappointments. There is more of a need to just reach those who are ready now and help them. Those who are not ready now for these messages of the Ministry will hardly be ready for the coming of the Lord!

A Testimony from Germany

Dear friend and brother,

I am well by HIS grace, for HE is **merciful and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in loving-kindness and truth**. This is HE. He went before Moses and proclaimed HIS name (Exodus 34:6). This is HIS character. And HE is revealing this more and more to me. He allows me to feel more and more HIS mercy for the people. HIS love is consuming me. I am more and more burdened with the burden of people, sometimes so heavily on my shoulders that I fall down. I fall down before HIM, literally, and weeping for the afflicted. HE is LORD. HE is GOD. HE is LOVE. Merciful and gracious. Abounding in loving-kindness. Sometimes the depression is so heavy, but HE is training me to bear it. HE allows me to feel how much HE is suffering for and with us. When we suffer, HE suffers also. It is beautiful, but also hard for me, for never before have I felt such a deep depression in my life. I

believe, HE and people suffer much more than I am allowed to feel now, but HE does not over challenge me. Praise HIM, for the burden leaves at least in the end of a day and then I feel again joy and easiness.

My studies are going on well. I have finished the practical part and am now every day at home studying for my final exams. Still 82 days to go to the written exams, and every day I need to study to get the amount of information done. But with HIS grace it is fun, and I will make it.

HE is deepening the lesson in me to teach me what Jesus lived and knew, what HE himself said in John 5:19 and 30: **'I am able to do nothing of myself...'** That seems to be my portion at the moment. But I am glad that this is going on, for my pride is huge and needs to be rooted out. It is killing my flesh and pride to experience that I am able to do nothing from myself, not even pray, or see the beauty of things, to enjoy, to rejoice. I can do nothing without HIS grace! I pray that this lesson goes on until all of my pride is rooted out, until it is a deep and mighty foundation in me and I will never again try to do something out of myself.

Therefore, because I can do nothing out of myself, my holidays with my parents in Wales were challenging. I could not enjoy the beauty of the countryside as much as I wanted. I am completely dependent on HIM. Unless HE opens my eyes for the beauty of HIS creation, for the things HE has done, is doing and will do, I cannot see them. All things seem to be grey, without beauty, lost, hopeless. I cannot enjoy anything what is not HIM. HE is my life, the love of my life. All I need is HIM. I love HIM so much. This love for HIM is consuming me. It is consuming me and working HIS way to salvation, to maturity, to perfection. It is the power of HIS love in me. It is HIS love in me. A burning fire. My zeal for HIM. **"For from HIM and through HIM and to HIM are all things. [For all things originate with HIM and come from HIM, and all things centre in and tend to consummate and to end in HIM.] To HIM be glory forever! Amen (so be it). (Romans.11:36). "For it was in HIM that all things were created, in heaven and on earth, things seen and things unseen, whether thrones, dominions, rulers, or authorities; all things were created and exist through HIM [by His service, intervention] an in and for HIM. And HE Himself existed before all things, and in HIM all things consist (cohere, are held together). (Colossians 1:16-17)**

I ask myself: "How does love look like?" What does it look like to live these verses: **"So be merciful (sympathetic, tender, responsive, and compassionate) even as your Father is."** (Luke 6:36)

"So then, whatever you desire that others would do to and for you, even so do also to and for them, for this is (sums up) the Law and the Prophets." (Matthew 7:12)

A Conversation concerning finding somewhere to live.

Dear Keith,

Since April 2013 I accepted this renting house on a temporary contract.

The building association decided to pull down my house and told me I have to leave this place on Friday 15 August 11 o'clock in the morning (Dutch time). Which gives me 8 weeks to find another place. If I understand the person right, they will disconnect my electricity and water supply on that date, I am not sure if they would take other action in getting me out. Because I do not have a job at this moment and I am living as a single man, my possibilities are limited some what.

What I am looking for is a place to rent, preferable ground floor in a quiet neighbourhood, at least one bedroom, a place where I can stay on a long time base, on the west side of Maastricht (in the area I am living at the moment). In Holland I can get financial benefit when my rent is under 700 euro per month. Every Wednesday they show available houses which are called social housing.

I believe that God has something for me to live, I only do not know if I am doing the right thing. At this moment I am checking the social housing on the internet. I also have put two advertisements in two elderly homes where I work as a volunteer. I hope to learn from this situation, as much as I can. I also notice satan is trying to get me doubt the Lord by using people in my church. Any help in prayer or advice is welcome.

The social worker will call me on Thursday for the result.

The Parable of the weights

I was about to go to church but realized that I had to transfer my son's set of weights from the boot of the car back into the house. These weights are in a large plastic case that is on wheels and weigh 150lbs. I struggled to lift them out of the boot and then started to wheel them towards the house. It took all my strength just to keep them upright and to wheel them along the pavement. Suddenly one of the wheels broke and came off, just as I got to the gate of our house. I couldn't go any further. What do I do Lord? "Open the case and transfer the weights one by one into the house". This I did and sure enough before long every weight was back in the case and in the house, it just took a bit longer.

But God doesn't miss any opportunities to teach us if our spiritual antennae are on and working. He said, "It is like life. If you experience too many heavy weights (problems) all at once it is too much for you to bear and we normally crack up under the strain. However if the same problems were spread out and we learned to deal with them one by one, then they become more bearable and we can cope. The trouble is we put all the problems into one basket and then sink under their weight instead of coming to God with each problem (just one weight 11kg) and asking Him how to deal with that one issue. As we identify each problem as a separate item, come to God with it in prayer and seek God for the practical solutions to the problem, obey what He says, then bit by bit, increment by increment the problems become less and less until we have the victory. We then find that we have coped with all the problems and the problems haven't got us, rather God has got the problem under control through us.

Matthew 11:28-30

Come to Me, all who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.

If you use a yoke you can carry a much larger weight than normal because the weight is balanced evenly over the shoulders. But the offer from God is that He will take the burden from you **IF** you let Him. **Don't be tempted to use your yoke (your coping strategy, drink, comfort eating etc) use His yoke.** If you don't let Him take your burdens, then you will have to carry them yourself and that is really difficult. Not to be recommended.

Hebrews 12:1 and 2



Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith.

I could hardly move these weights from the car to my house let alone run with them. However if I had split all the weights up and attached them individually to a yoke I could have moved a lot faster and carried them for a greater distance. But having said all that, it seems as if I was not designed to carry the weights anyway. When I give all these weights (problems) to Jesus, they cease to be my problem, they become His problem and therefore they are no problem at all. Now the actual problem you are experiencing may still be there for a period of time until it is resolved, but the weight of the problem (the worry, the anxiety which is what affects me so much) has gone. I am free like an astronaut in space, weightless, just floating through space, which takes no effort as the work is done for me.
