NATO strap

These straps are usually made of nylon material and they are quite thin compared to the other type of straps. The straps easily slip between the spring bars and the case of the watch hence making them easy to install.

Bracelet strap

These are the metallic straps which are normally heavier than the rest of the straps. The material that makes these straps includes stainless steel, titanium, brass and gold among others. Given that leather straps are quite uncomfortable when wet, the bracelet straps are preferred by divers and those who happen to be around water a lot.



Croc-embossed strap

These are normal leather straps which have been embossed with a crocodile pattern to make them look suave and expensive. Unlike the [NATO Strap](#) or rubber straps, these straps are thick and heavier. The crocodile imprint on the leather is widely accepted and it's pretty common to find men donning a watch with one.

Rally strap

You probably have seen wristwatch straps whose holes start right next to the lugs. The holes bring about a sense of beauty and aeration around the wrist. Even in a sweaty humid situation, your wrist still gets a lot of air and the strap doesn't cling on to the wrist.
